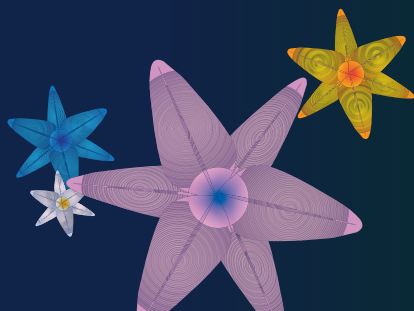

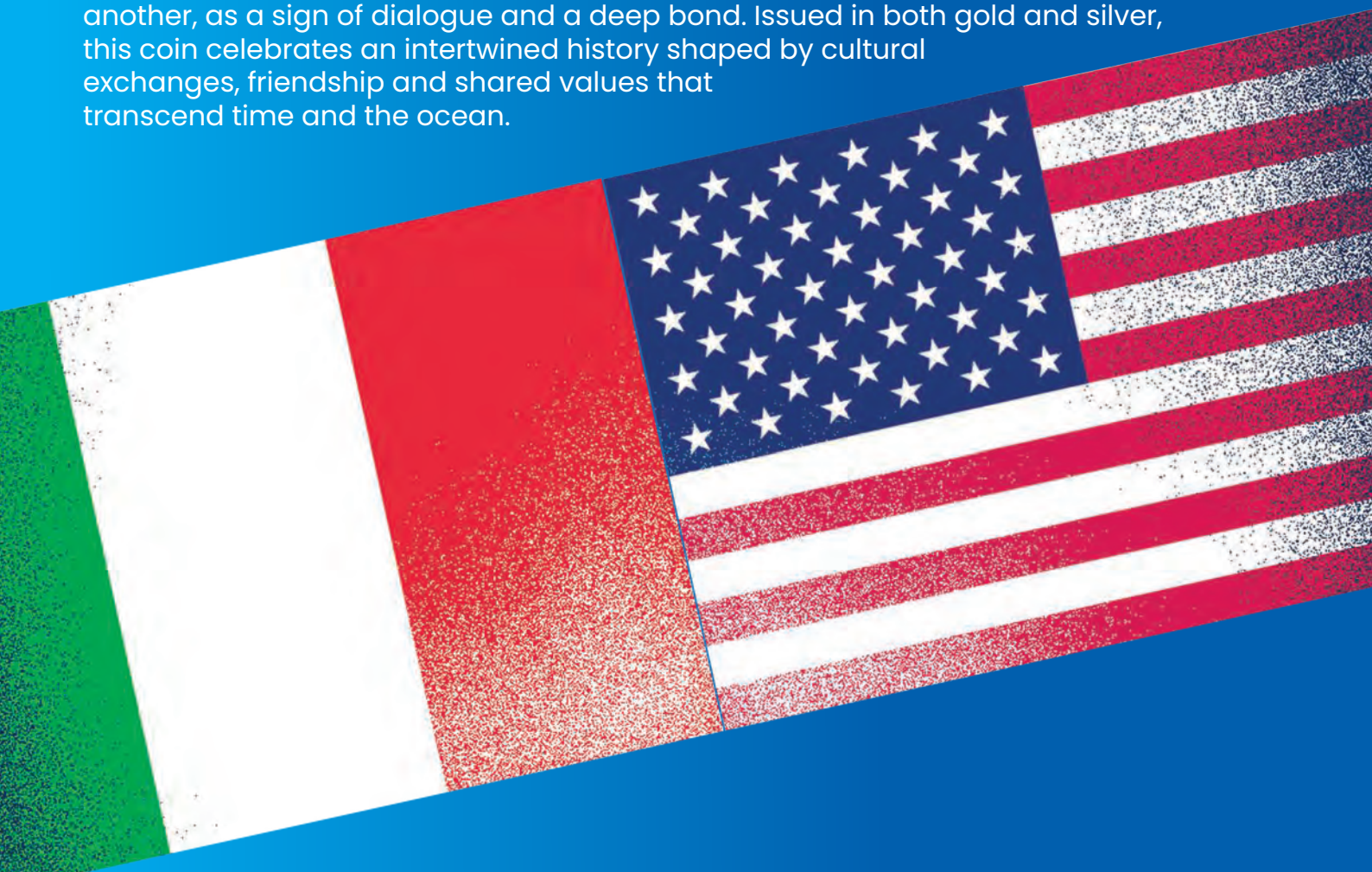

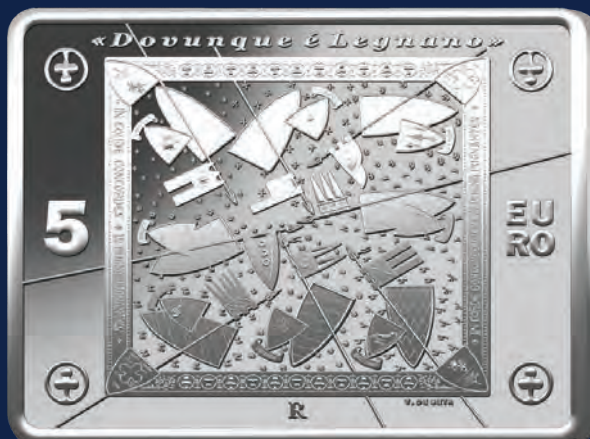

NUMISMATIC GLOSSARY

Proof

The finish of a coin is defined Proof because of the extremely shiny effect of the flat parts (like a mirror) that contrasts with the opaque effect of the relief. Proof coins are minted one by one, using dies previously polished with diamond pastes.

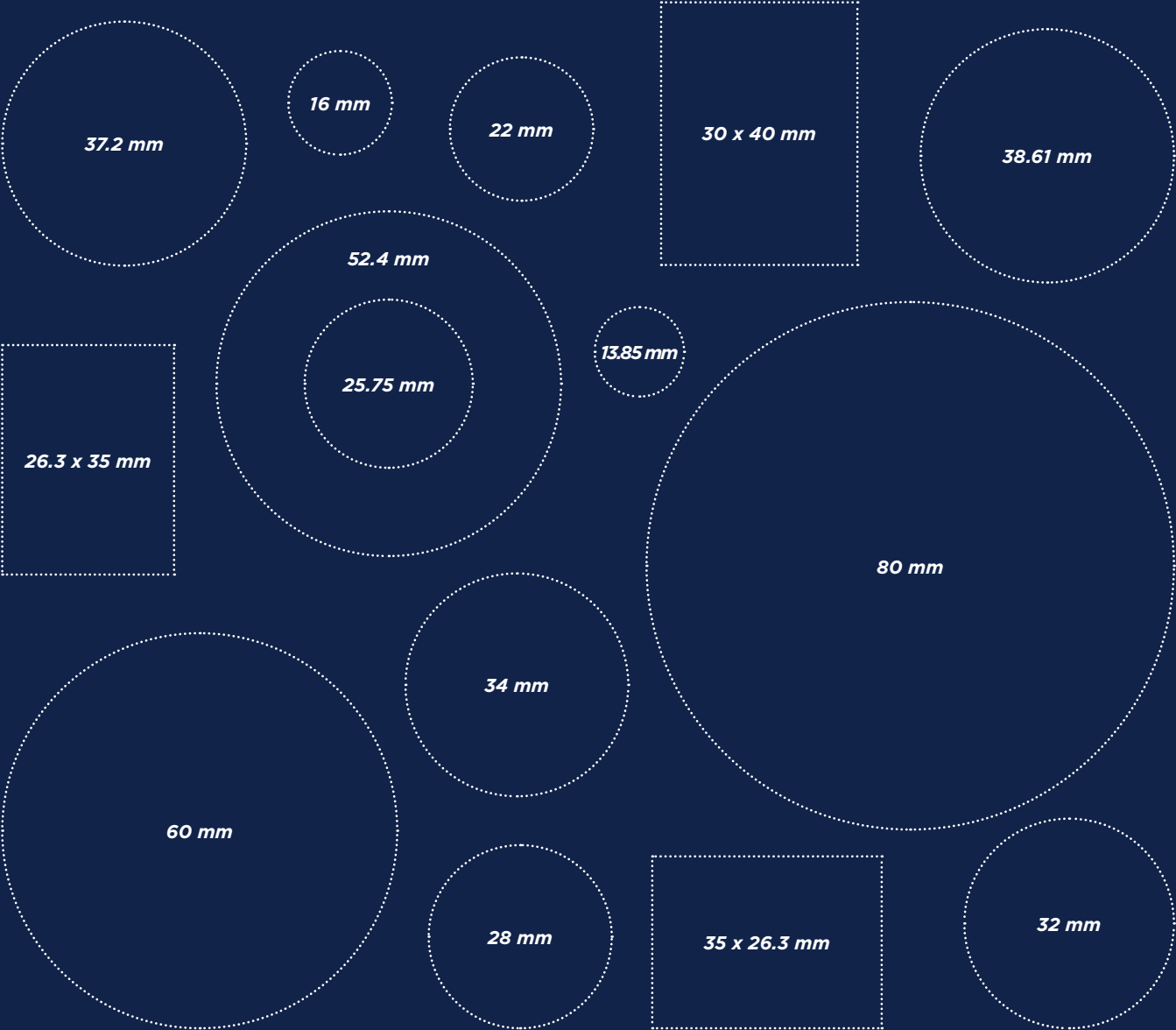
SU

SU stands for Special Uncirculated. These coins are the best part of a standard production, made with brand new dies. The designs and writings are well defined, and the finish is uniform. The production is carried out with a reduced press speed, compared to circulating coinage, to ensure a better definition of the product.

Reverse Proof

Reverse Proof (RP) coins offer a fascinating reversal compared to Proofs. Unlike classic shiny coins, in which the design elements shine on a perfectly polished, reflective background, RP coins have an opaque background that highlights the shiny elements in relief.
